

Northern Lights

This is an unique tour of great contrasts: big cities like Berlin, Hamburg and Copenhagen on the one hand and beautiful islands in the Baltic and the North Sea on the other.

02. Jun, Day 1: „The German Capital“

Leaving Dresden in the early morning. Arrival at Berlin at appr. 11H. The biggest town in Germany offers everything You can imagine, and even more... Contrasts everywhere. During the guided tour You follow historical tracks but also discover the „new“ Berlin, modern, phantastic, shrilly . The main attractions: Brandenburger Tor, Unter den Linden, Nicolaiviertel, Charlottenburg Palace, Reichstag, etc. In the evening You should visit one of various theaters. Overnight in the Hotel Estrel.

03. Jun, Day 2: „From Berlin to Usedom“

Through the wonderful countryside of the „Uckermark“, after a lunch break at one of the hundreds of lakes in this area, You reach the Island of Usedom.

04. Jun, Day 3: „Around the Island“

During a carriage tour You discover the Island, which partly belongs to Poland. Main attraction in Ahlbeck, the „Seebrücke“, a wooden pier, built in 1899. Backdrop for many movies and pictures.

05. Jun, Day 4: „Rügen“

Totally different: the landscape on this Island. Landmarks are the chalk cliffs, You will see during Your trip along the fishermans villages on the way to the northeast point Kap Arkona.

06. Jun, Day 5: „Husum“

Passing by the hanseatic towns of Rostock and Lübeck You reach the „grey town on the sea“, the birth town of a famous German poet, Theodor Storm. You walk on the tracks of his romantical stories.

07. Jun, Day 6: „Sylt“

By train over the „Hindenburg Dam“ the group reaches the most fashionable island of Germany, destination for „the rich and the beautiful“. Time for leisure. What about a relaxing hour in one of the beach basket chairs ?

08 Jun, Day 7: „Sights of Hamburg“

Today Our Coach brings You to the „Venice of the North“. (Hamburg has more bridges., than the town in Italy !) Therefor Your sightseeing tour partly includes boat rides, for example the port with several „windjammers“, the „Speicherstadt“, the Alster Lakes and even a visit to the town hall. After dinner : enjoy a famous musical like Mamma Mia, Dirty Dancing or King of Lions .

09. Jun, Day 8: „Helgoland“

Along the Elbe river to Cuxhafen. From here ferry boats bring You to Germanys only „open sea island“ and therefor a duty-free-area. With its red cliff the whole island is a unique landmark !

10. Jun, Day 9: „Copenhagen - the Danish Capital“

Finally You pass the last German island - Fehmarn - on Your way to Danmark. You reach Copenhagen via the so called „Vogelfluglinie“, the route of the migration birds between Scandinavia and Southern Europe.
