

Norwegian Highlights

The top of Europe : Norway ! A real „long“ country. The direct distance from the capital Oslo to the Northern Cape equals the distance of Oslo to Rome. And - even longer - the deeply by fjords indented coastline . It measures half around the globe and shows fissured landscapes with snow-covered craggy mountains. Waterfalls, romantic wooden cottages, friendly scandinavian people and legends of fairys and trolls: an enchanting country!

02.Jun, Day 1: „ Baltic Cruise“

Early departure . Passing Berlin and Hamburg You reach the Sea Port of Kiel and at appr. 14H embark on one of the modern Color Line - Ferries, offering the comfort of cruising ships. In the evening as dinner enjoy a famous „Scandinavian Buffet“.

03.Jun, Day 2: „Oslo - the Capital“

Arrival at appr. 9H. During the city tour amongst other attractions You see the townhall, the Vigeland Park, and Holmenkollen (the world famous skiing center) . In the evening You reach Lillehammer, the town of the Winter Olympics 1994. Dinner and overnight at the „SAS Hotel Lillehammer.“

04.Jun, Day 3: „Trolls and Fairys“

A fascinating tour on breath-taking roads through the land of legends: Gudbrandsdal, Romsdal, Andalsnes. Keep Your eyes open! Might be, You see one of the trolls with the long, red nose.... The „Eagle Road“ leads You to Geiranger.

05.Jun, Day 4: „From Geiranger to Hellesylt“

One day on the Geiranger Fjord, the most impressive fjord in Norway. You pass by the Briksdals-Glacier. The tour with the ferry boat will be an unforgettable adventure.

06.Jun, Day 5: „ Bergen - the pearl of the Hardanger-Fjord“

Bergen is the capital of „Fjord-Norway“. Surrounded by mountains with icing-sugar tops. Highlights of the guided tour are the historical city-center, the Marienkirche and the Fort Berghusen. Overnight at the „Rica Hotel“ on the banks of the Ulvikfjord.

07.Jun, Day 6: „Cruise on the Sognefjord“

You leave the Hardangerfjord to Voss .Before You reach the Hotel „Bardola“ in Geilo, the afternoon highlight is a cruise on the longest and deepest Fjord of Norway.

08.Jun, Day 7: „Back to Oslo“

During the return trip to the capital through the Nume-Valley You may enjoy again the delightful landscapes with its pearls of nature, typical norwegian villages and buildings, like the wooden churches. In the evening: Oslo once again.

09.Jun, Day 8: „Good Bye Norway“

Along the coastline the route leads to Gothenburg, the 2nd-biggest town in Sweden and an important port and trading place. Worthwhile to see: the townhall, the „Kronhuset“, the Opera House and various amusement parks like Liseberg and Slottkogsparken..

10.Jun, Day 9: „Malmö“

The final destination of the tour - farther south -is Malmö. Arrival in Your Hotel in the early evening.
